If Clinical Symptoms respond well to ToT:

You may be a good candidate for FMT.

Proceed with 1<sup>st</sup> FMT planning consult.

If Clinical Symptoms respond poorly to ToT:

- You may not benefit from FMT
- Consider discharge back into care of GP

## **Diagnostic Investigations (DI):**

DI may be necessary and could include:

- Panendoscopy and / or Colonoscopy
- Blood & Stool Tests
- Other tests, as clinically necessary





## **Unexpected Finding:**

If DI results identify an alternate cause of your condition this will be treated accordingly.

- Examples of unexpected findings are faecal parasites, bacteria or viruses.
- If symptoms persist after treating the unexpected finding, a ToT may be

#### **Faecal Microbiota Transplant (FMT)**

FMT treatment courses & costs associated can vary depending on the indication for treatment & severity of condition. Examples of FMT courses:

- C.difficile Infection: 3 Treatments over 2 days
- UC: 32 Treatments over 6 months



## **Post FMT Consults:**

Three Months after 1st FMT:

- Consult with Doctor or the CNS (for Prof Borody's patients only)
- Dietitian Follow-up
- Progress check

Six Months after 1st FMT:

Consult with Gastroenterologist
